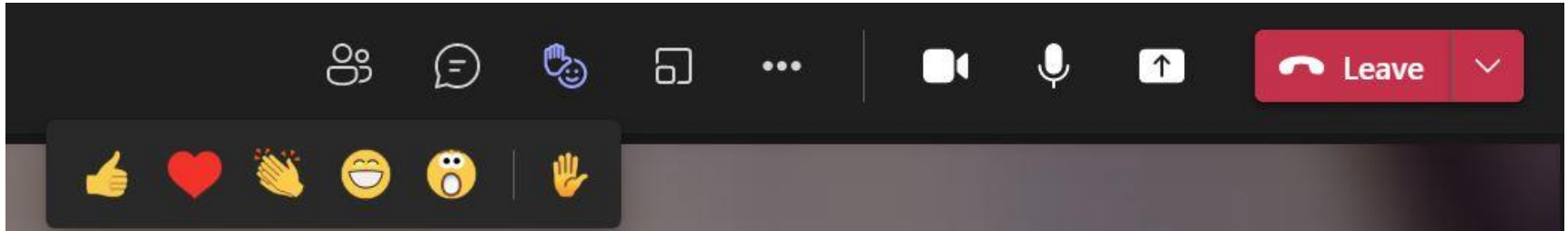

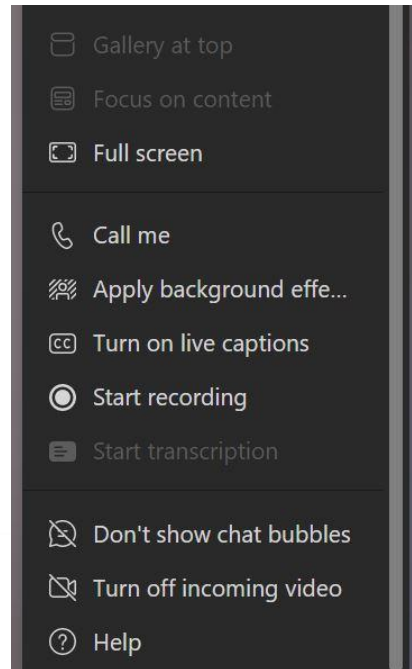
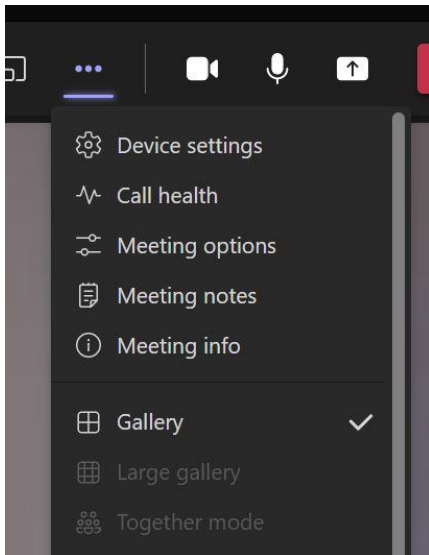

- The [NDC Handover Checklist](#) is a tool **created for governments** to document all information relevant to their NDC revision and update process.
- Its main objective is to **maintain the knowledge of the key aspects from the recent NDC revision process** and thereby **prepare for future NDC update processes**.
- The checklist is developed as a **flexible template** that can be **tailored to the context of each country**. Governments can fill in the checklist and share it with relevant stakeholders at their own discretion.
- The tool was developed based on the **experience of GIZ and Climate Analytics** as well as experts from partner organizations.
