


Context

- Observations from the 2020-2021 NDC revision:
 - Limited background information and data on the first NDC
 - required additional resources
 - caused delays
 - posed a challenge for relevant discussions
 - External support for NDC revision by development partners
 - each partner worked on different elements of the NDC
 - various methods and approaches
 - High staff turnover in state agencies
 - insufficient institutional memory

Key considerations for the Checklist:

- Collaborative and coordinated approach to filling the Checklist:
 - National NDC Focal Point, environmental or climate change authorities, ministries, external partners or consultants
 - Reflection session or a workshop with key stakeholders
- NDC Focal Point should lead the process of filling in the Checklist:
 - External partners can support with filling in the Checklist
- Identify appropriate storge place for the Checklist:
 - Ideally store in digital and/or online version in governmental database (if such exist)
 - Ensure the Checklist is available in 2-3 years for the new round of NDC updates


